Dear Mr President:

I am concerned about corruption.

Mr Musk's vast government power has drawn rulings from Judges Cooper, Bates, Chutkan and Chuang to provide documentation. His business interests have taken tens of billions in federal money and likely violate federal law around conflicts yet no disclosure has been made. At least ten agencies besides USAid which Senator Warren notes he has 'hamstrung' had previously acted against Mr Musk for everything from securities fraud to rocket safety violations. Replacing federal workers with AI and a cryptocurrency reserve would both aid his interests while Starlink will likely gain a large contract the FAA just canceled with Verizon. Foreign policy also appears tuned to his business interests. Luckily Press Secretary Leavitt assures us that 'Elon will excuse himself' should a conflict arise.

Please assure me that you will investigate Mr Musk.
