Dear Senator Arreguin:

I am concerned about the federal regime.

As my senator (and fellow Capitol Corridor rider) you have greater visibility to call out the escalating lawlessness. There is a clear need for both administrative pushback where your chairmanship of the Public Safety Committee will play a role as well as mass resistance. Human rights are being violated with kidnappings by ICE, rendition to El Salvador, arbitrary revocation of immigration status and imprisonment without charge or habeas opportunities. Laws are not being faithfully executed with the destruction of USAID, mass firings of federal workers and termination of diversity programs. There is racketeering with universities, law firms and state and local governments being threatened with funding cuts while their leaders are personally coerced with loss of court access or in the case of Mayor Adams federal charges.

Please support and join me protesting these abuses in the streets.
